Dear Community of Saint Joseph's;

My gratitude to everyone who has made this a truly holy time for all of us at Saint Joseph's. My welcome to those new members of our parish family brought to us through the process of the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults and Children*. To our guests this Easter – my invitation to join us every day on our journey through the cross to the resurrection.

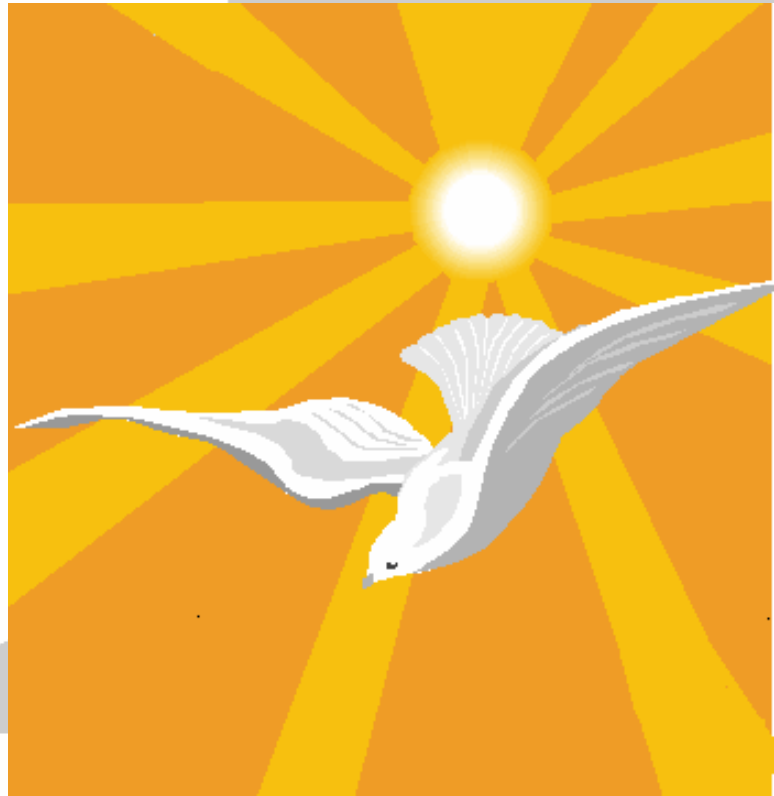
