The first of these sites include weekly reviews by Father Jude Siciliano, OP, who conducted the retreat at Saint Joseph's earlier this year.

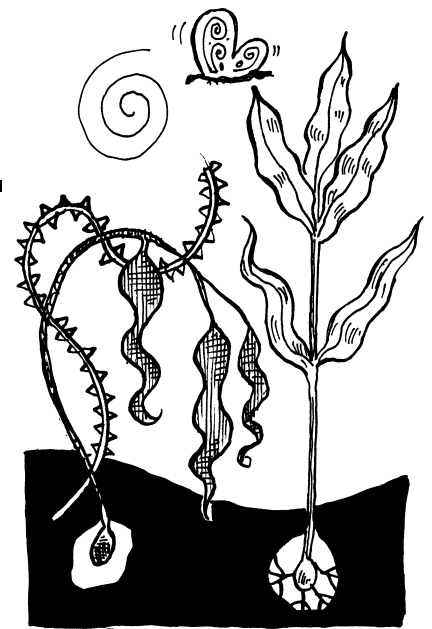
